Albatross Yacht Shipyard has just introduced a brand-new concept in the world of sailing, not only that, it has developed a new way to fit your family into a program with large outdoor living spaces and great interiors. Albatross Yacht was born in 2011 and currently manufactures its vessels upon request with several customization-possibilities.

This Albatross 42.1 has been made based on its predecessor, the Albatross 40 Panoramic, but in order to suit the customer's preferences, it has been modified on several of its features: prolonging the hard top over the bathtub, step on the stern platform and open pulpit in the exterior, as well as wheel government and two cabins instead of three inside.

All at one level
One of the highlights is that the living room and kitchen are at the same level as the bath outside, so that if we add the two areas, we'll linked thanks to two sliding doors, we have a large living space on board during the day, shifting to a lower level for the overnight and hygienic spaces.

Outside the bathtub it is very spacious and you will be able to enjoy double binnacle with comfortable benches. It does a tilting platform which is also the door of a small garage, something unique and unusual in these lengths. The central table does folding leaves with high capacity and all this space is largely protected and secured by the ex ➔



The total length of the boat has been increased due to an additional step on the platform that allows you to access to the bathroom without opening that step.



The cover is walk-around. In the centre we have a marvellous space for optional mat and a solarium. The self-tacking jib has been carefully made to simplify the manoeuvre on a new family-navigation concept.

The Albatross 42.1 maintains the same appearance as its predecessor, furthermore it incorporates brilliant new features like a long hard top over the bathtub.

tended superior hard top. The corridors that join the stern and the bow are perfectly comfortable, secure and very handy. Here we find anchors chest and a self-tacking jib, making navigation a pleasure to be experienced.

Great volumes

In the interior we firstly find a spacious living room and kitchen, with the same round panoramic views of its predecessor, the Albatross 40 Panoramic, which makes it feel very open. This unit has a built-in internal government position, comfortable and accurately situated.

The interior cabin is intended to spend the night with two large double cabins, being up to the ship-

owner which stateroom is set the main one. The front cabin does a central island-shaped bed, a wardrobe and a desk, all comfortably sized. Moving up to the starboard aft cabin, it has the bed in the transverse direction and in the dressing area we also find a small desk or dresser. The toilet occupies the port side, with separate shower. All services and stowage spaces are very spacious due to the concept of the boat so that the facilities are very well set with large and wide spaces.
